Fort Belknap, MT - one Thursday per month.

Fort Belknap Paper-Based Testing dates:

May 15, Jun 12, Jul 17, Aug 21

Fort Belknap PBT testing starts at 10:00 A.M.

Havre, MT - two Wednesdays of each month.

Havre Computer-Based Testing dates

May 07 & 28, Jun 11 & 25, Jul 09 & 23, Aug 13 & 27

District 4 HRDC CBT testing starts at 09:30 A.M.

Stone Child College, MT - one Wednesday per month.

Stone Child Computer Based Testing dates:

Stone Child CBT testing starts at 10:00 A.M.

General Testing Policies

- ❖ Test fees must be paid to PSI online or over the phone to register for testing.
 - PSI Test fees are good for 1 year from the date of purchase. If testing is not completed in this amount of time, new fees will be assessed.
- ❖ HRDC Testing Fees are per test and day – each attempt of a subtest incurs a \$5 fee. This fee must be paid directly to HRDC before an individual will be allowed to test.
 - Test center fees must be paid to HRDC before or on the testing day. **Please have exact fee amount for HRDC as we are unable to make change.**
 - If another agency is paying for your test fee due to HRDC, you must bring confirmation with you (a letter from the paying party). Examples of other agencies: 477 Services in Fort Belknap, Stone Child HiSET prep, Aaniiih Nakoda College HiSET prep, Tribal TANF
- ❖ Failure to arrive within **10 minutes** of the scheduled testing time will result in rescheduling. Additional fees may be imposed.
- ❖ A **photo ID is required** on the day of testing. ID must contain the name as it appears on the registration, birthdate, and signature. If you have an out-of-state ID, you must bring in proof of residence such as mail in your name delivered to your Montana address.
- ❖ **Cell phones or other electronic devices, food or drink, testing aids, and personal calculators are not allowed in the testing room.**
- ❖ Clients who are **17 or 18** years of age must have an original school document from their former school clearly identifying the candidate by name, date of birth, and last school enrollment date; granting approval for the student to take the test and signed by chief education officer submitted to HRDC **at least 72 hours prior to testing** for Chief Examiner approval.
- ❖ Clients who are **16 years of age** must contact Chief Examiner to discuss the eligibility process to test.
- ❖ **Former GED test scores are no longer valid.**

Failure to adhere to any of these rules may result in dismissal from the test, forfeiture of fees, and cancellation of scores.
